


The Nest 10 Hole, Par 3

The Nest is a Par 3, 10-hole routing perched on the highest point of Cabot Cliffs, affording some of the best views on property. The goal of this Rod Whitman & Dave Axland designed course is to offer the excitement and thrills of a traditional golf round, but one that can be played with a handful of clubs in a fraction of the time. Anticipate interesting greens, with



short grass surrounds and the same style of rustic, rugged bunkers that are found throughout Cabot Links and Cabot Cliffs. Whether it's the quest for that elusive ace, the chasing of daylight during the late-fall days or a travel day that leaves you aching to stretch your legs, the short course is the fix for all of it.



Hiking & Walking


Off the Course

Discover the unique natural beauty of the western side of the island with a local guide who can show you popular hiking trails. Go for a dip at a secluded lake, or stop for a picnic overlooking Northumberland Strait fishing boats from 1,000 feet above sea level. With plenty of options for all skill levels, Cape Breton is fantastic for hiking and walking.

Easy – Family-friendly trails suitable for all visitors

Moderate – Medium-length trails with moderate elevation gain and some short, steep sections; suitable for most visitors

Difficult – Longer trails with long, steep sections suitable for visitors who have trail experience and are prepared




Inverness Boardwalk

Travel: 1 minute

Duration: 30 minutes

Difficulty: Easy

Beginning just off Inverness's Central Avenue and continuing along the Inverness Beach and the Cabot Links golf course, the Inverness Boardwalk offers miles of panoramic views in every direction. Amidst the coastal scenery and refreshing ocean breeze, it's the ideal spot for a relaxing stroll or jog.



Gypsum Mine Trail

Travel: 50 minutes

Duration: 1 hour loop

Difficulty: Easy

This short hike on an established trail follows an old railway bed, built in the early 1900s. As such, the Gypsum Mine Trail is wide and flat, welcoming hikers, bikers, and the occasional ATV. Eventually you'll arrive at white gypsum cliffs and a lovely swimming spot at a pristine emerald lake, near the Acadian village of Cheticamp.




Uisge Ban Falls

Travel: 1 hour

Duration: 1 – 2 hours; 4 km (2.4 mi)

Difficulty: Easy

Gaelic for “white water”, Uisge Ban (ish-ka-ban) offers picnic facilities, interpretive signs, and gorgeous hiking trails. The Falls Trail—which is approximately three kilometres (1.8 miles) in length, and requires about one hour to complete—passes through unspoiled forests, fields, and streams. It leads to the 16-metre (52-foot) Uisge Ban Waterfall, where 150-metre (500-foot) gorge walls tower on either side.




Skyline Trail

Travel: 1 hour

Duration: 2 – 3 hours; 8.2-km (5.1-mi) loop

Difficulty: Easy

Likely Cape Breton’s most talked-about trail experience, the Skyline Trail is a looping, hiking trail on the western side of The Cabot Trail. A dramatic headland cliff overlooks the coast from the end of this level trail, offering stunning views of The Cabot Trail as it winds its way down the mountain towards the sea. Along the route, whales can be spotted in the Gulf of St. Lawrence, while moose, eagles, and boreal birds also frequent the area.




Cape Breton Highlands National Park

Travel: Varied

Duration: Varied

Difficulty: Easy - Difficult

The trails in Cape Breton Highlands National Park range from easy strolls to challenging climbs, with panoramic views of canyons, highlands, and seacoasts. Awaken your senses as you explore remote waterfalls, tranquil lakes, sweeping panoramic views, and cliff-bound river canyons through a guided back-country hike with one of the park's knowledgeable staff.



Egypt Falls

Travel: 25 minutes

Duration: 1 – 2 hours; 2-km (1.2-mi) loop

Difficulty: Difficult

Egypt Falls or Piper's Glen as you may find in some guide books, features a short 15-minute trail to the falls, descending downhill through a stand of mixed hardwoods. The last five-minutes force you to ascend the steep walls of the gorge, revealing a beautiful waterfall. Ropes are in place for added support. A great spot to have a swim, and relax in nature with a picnic and some good company.



Fishing

Off the Course

Inverness and the surrounding area is not just home to two of the world's greatest golf courses. It also offers the largest concentration of Bluefin tuna in the world and some of the finest salmon fishing on Earth.

Salmon Fishing on the Margaree River

One of the best fly-fishing experiences anywhere in the World, the Margaree River is blessed with several species of fish, which either inhabit the river or return from the surrounding oceans each year to spawn. It is the Atlantic Salmon that make the Margaree River world famous, however, speckled (Brook) trout, brown trout and more recently, Striped Bass are found in abundance. Fall is a spectacular time of year



on the Margaree, with the surrounding mountains seemingly on fire with colour. The fall season on the Margaree is also known for Atlantic Salmon which range in size from 10 to 12lbs, reaching up to 40lbs. This is your chance to embark on a world class fly fishing experience on Cape Breton Island's Margaree River. We will connect you with our experienced, passionate and knowledgeable



in-house guide, Jimmie Pederson, who can give you instruction on the basics or, for the advanced sportsmen, tips on the best pools and local flies. Before the day on the Margaree starts, you can also visit The Margaree Fish Hatchery in Margaree Valley, which produces thousands of salmon and brook trout in support of the Margaree River. The season runs from June 1 to October 31.

The Margaree River is fly fishing only.



Being out on the water is one of the best ways to explore the shimmering seas, beautiful coastline, and natural wonders of Cape Breton. Inverness and the surrounding region offer a variety of whale watching and boat tours—be it by sailboat, cruiser, or even aboard a working fishing vessel.




Margaree Island

The tour to Margaree Island is a two-hour journey, alighting from the main harbor in Inverness. After a short steam to the island in a local fishing boat, you can view the amazing creatures found here, including up close and personal whale sightings. Sea Wolf Island National Wildlife Area (NWA),




locally referred to as Margaree Island, is located 4 km off the coast of Cape Breton. Prominently in view from both Cabot Links and Cabot Cliffs, Margaree Island and its surrounding waters support a wealth of wildlife and migratory birds. Over forty species of birds and seventy plant species



have been recorded on the island. In addition, you will see the largest colony of Grey seals found anywhere along the shores of Sea Wolf Island. Also learn about the history of Sea Wolf Island and hear the family stories of early lighthouse keepers. Other frequent sightings include Dolphin

and Harbor Porpoises, Giant Bluefin Tuna, Leatherback Turtles, Ocean Sunfish, Black Back Gulls, Herring Gulls, Great Blue Heron, Bald Eagles as well as an eagle's nest on the rocky sandstone cliff.



Whale Watching


The shores hugging Cape Breton Island are teeming with sea life and present one of the best locations in Nova Scotia to experience a close encounter and say hello to the Atlantic Ocean's gentle giants: pods of friendly Pilot and Minke whales, great Humpbacks and Finbacks, as well as dolphins, porpoises, seals and many other marine wildlife call these waters home.



Located a short drive away in the Acadian village of Cheticamp, hop aboard the 44 foot "Love Boat" where you will not only experience some of the best whale watching, but also the chance to view the magnificent coastline that makes the Cape Breton Highlands National Park and the Cabot Trail one of the most scenic destinations in the world.

This trip is also available out of Inverness Harbor in August – September.




Boat Tour with On-Board Lobster Supper
